1. Executive summary

2. Risk analysis

The role of a Warehouse Shift Lead in Dubai faces a medium to high redundancy risk over the next 3-5 years due to advancements in automation and warehouse management systems (WMS).



Tasks With High Automation Potential Include

- **Inventory counting:** Drones and automated sensors can perform cycle counts with greater speed and accuracy.
- **Goods movement:** Automated Guided Vehicles (AGVs) and robotic arms are increasingly handling the physical picking, packing, and sorting of items.
- **Data entry:** Barcode scanning and RFID technology have already minimized manual data entry, and this trend will continue with more integrated systems.

However, several core functions of your role remain valuable and are difficult to automate. These are the skills to emphasize in your transition:

- **People management:** Leading, motivating, and resolving conflicts within a team requires human empathy and leadership.
